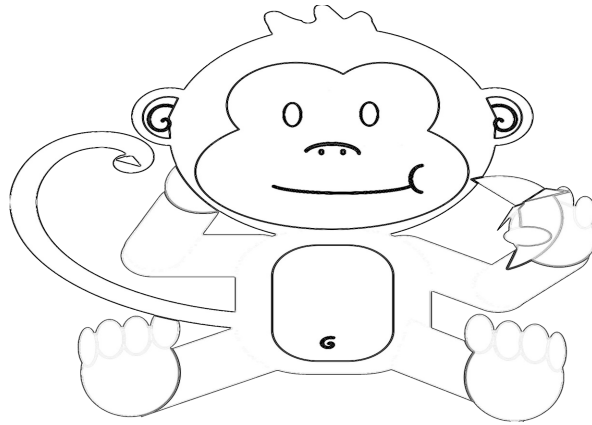

Meet The Animal: Monkey



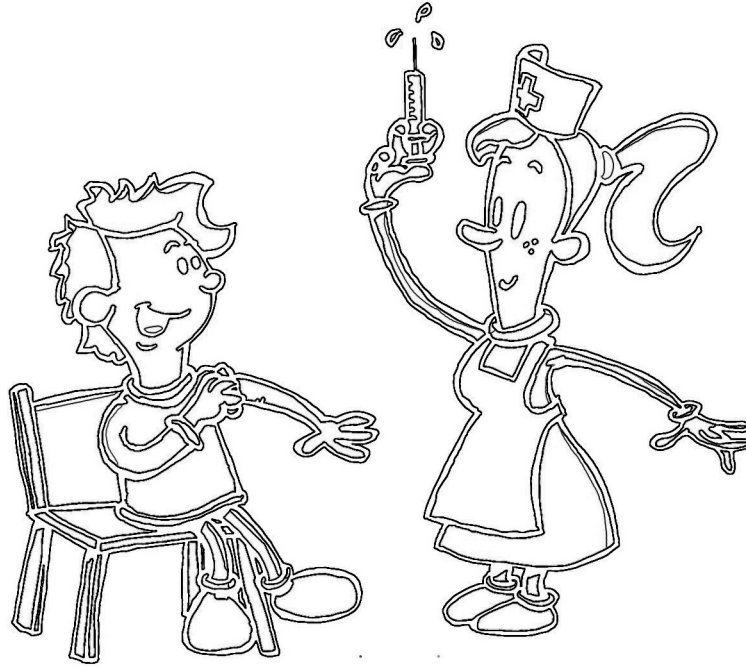
Monkeys are clever and social animals. They are known for running and leaping on trees, and are part of the mammal group. There are 200 species, or types of monkeys. Monkeys can be found in Africa, Asia, Central and South America. Most monkeys live mainly in rainforests in trees.

Most monkeys are active during the day. Monkeys are intelligent, and live in groups. They eat different types of food such as fruit, flowers, seeds, shoots, roots, and leaves. Some types of monkeys eat birds' eggs, insects, and other small animals.

Females pregnancy can range between five to seven months, and they give birth to one baby. Babies are born helpless and depend on the mother for care. Monkeys reach adulthood between the ages of three and four.
