

Elisha



Elisha was one of Jehovah's prophets in the 10th and 9th century B.C.E. Elisha served as Elijah's attendant for about six years.

Jehovah chose Elisha as Elijah's successor about 917 B.C.E. and he received Elijah's official garmet. Before Jehovah sweeps up Elijah in a windstorm, Elisha asks him for "a double portion" of his spirit. Elijah told him that this was not his to give, and that if he sees him depart, then he will get what he asked for. Jehovah allowed Elisha to see Elijah depart, so he was able to receive what he had asked for.

Elisha ends up performing twice the amount of miracles as Elijah:


















Axhead Comes To The Surface






