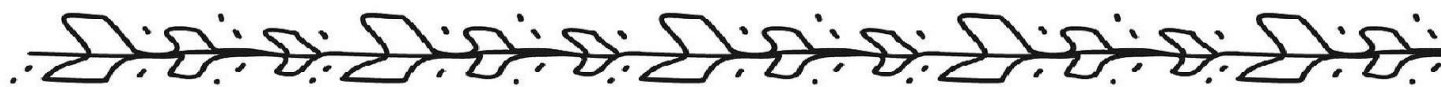


Jehovah Says

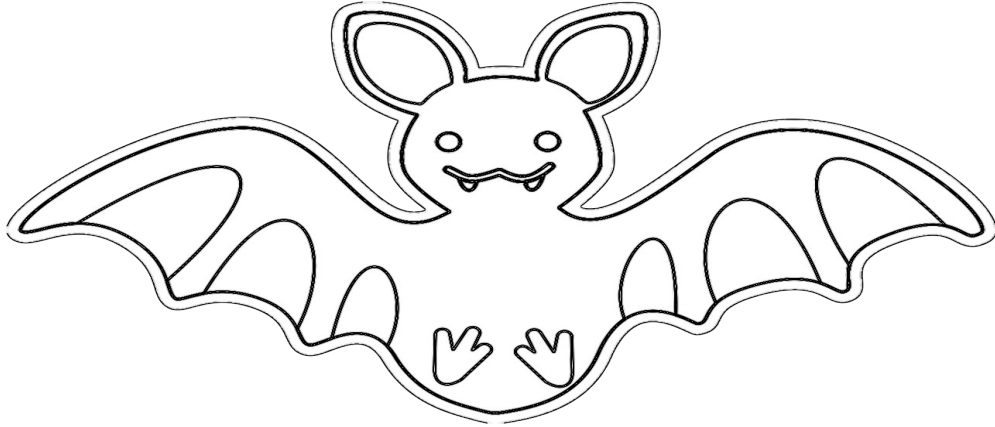

Meet The Animal:: Bat

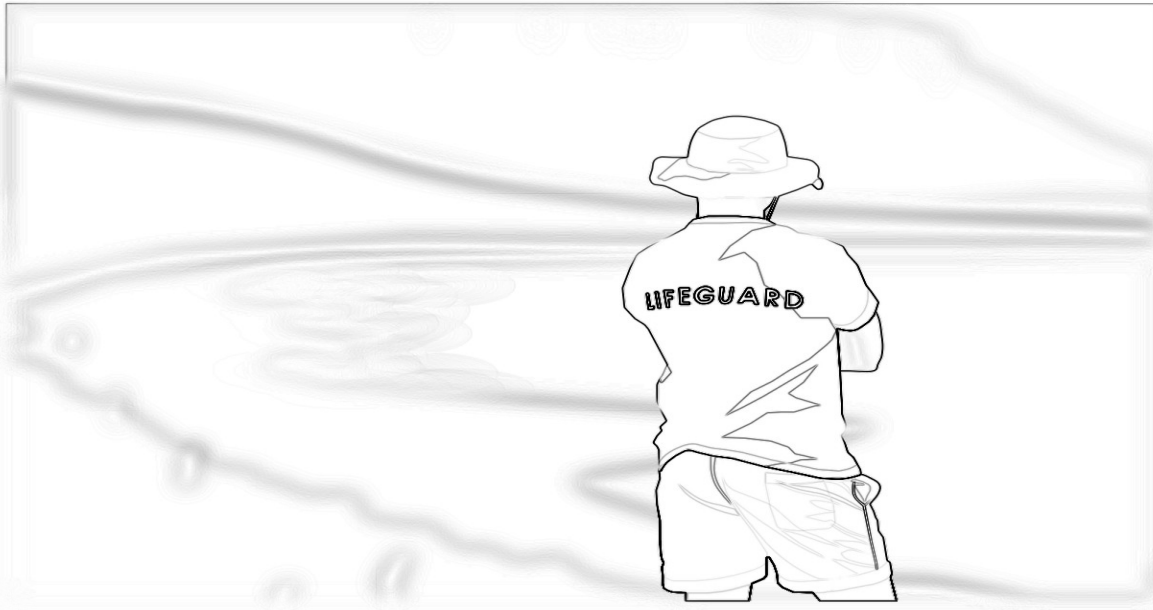


Bats are flying mammals, and are the only mammals capable of true and sustained flight. They are more agile in flight than most birds. They are the second largest mammals after rodents, and comprise about 20% of all classified mammal species worldwide, with over 1,400 species.

Many bats eat insects, while others eat fruit, nectar, and even animals. Bats are nocturnal, and many live in caves or other refuges. They live throughout the world, except regions with extremely cold weather. They are important in their ecosystem for pollinating flowers and dispersing seeds.

Community Worker: Lifeguard



To become a lifeguard one must be certified. Classes are 25-30 hours and held over the course of a few days. At the end of the certification class, lifeguards are required to take a final exam and must pass it to become certified. Out of water skills such as CPR and first aid will be taught, in-water skills such as active victim rescue (conscious swimmer) and passive- victim rescue(unconscious swimmer).

A lifeguard is responsible for the safety of people in an area of water, whether it is the beach, inland body of water, pool, lagoon, or waterpark. Their duty is to enforce rules, maintain concentrated observation of the duty area, supervise equipment such as at a waterpark, effect rescues and other emergency action as necessary, give first aid if someone gets hurt, and help clean areas around the beach/pool.
