

Holstein Cow

Holstein cows are black and white, or red and white. They weigh about 1,500 pounds and are about 58 inches tall at the shoulder when they reach maturity. They are originally from Europe, and were brought over to the United States in 1852. Once they were established in Massachusetts, the Holstein breed were sought after by many breeders.

A baby cow is called a calf, and they can weigh over 90 pounds at birth, that is one big baby! Female cows, called heifers, can be bred when they weigh about 800 pounds, at about 15 months old. But it is more desirable to breed them between 24 and 27 months. Gestation lasts about nine months, similar to a human pregnancy.

Holsteins are able to adapt to many types of environments, this is why they can be found nationwide and dominate the United States' milk production industry. Nine out of ten farmers currently use Holsteins for their milk. They provide 24,958 pounds of milk, 920 pounds of butterfat, and 710 pounds of protein per year! Do you like to drink milk?

Community Worker: Judge



In order to be a judge you need a university degree in law and experience as a lawyer. A judge presides over court proceedings either alone or as a panel of judges. A judge hears all witnesses and evidence presented by lawyers that are working on a case. They have to assess the credibility and arguments of the parties involved, and then issue a ruling based on their interpretation of the law, and their own personal judgment. A judge is expected to conduct the trial impartially and usually in an open court. A judge makes sure that all trial proceedings are lawful and orderly.
