> 2. Due regard for the feelings, wishes, rights, or traditions of others.

2)**Jehovah's Organization**-Theocratic things, Elders, our brothers and sisters, holy things, Judicial decisions, kingdom hall.(Hebrews 10:24,25,Hebrews 13:17, 1Peter 2:17, 2Thess. 1:6-9, Deut. 17:10-13, 1 Corinthians 14:33,40)

3) Within the family- Between husbands and wives, for children, for parents, between siblings.(Ephesians 5:33, Ephesians 6:4, Leviticus 19:2,3, 1 John 3:11,12)

4) **For Life**- Pregnancies, your own life and body, another person's life,blood.(Exodus 21:22,23; Romans 12:1, Exodus 20:13, Lev. 17:14)

5) For the authorities- Government, courts, police.(Romans 13:1,2)
